Welcome to Adventurebug's JORDAN CHARITY CHALLENGE, one of our once-in-a-lifetime Bucket List Expeditions!




By taking part in our fundraising EVENTS and expeditions, you can have a deeply positive impact on YOUR ORGANIZATION's work being done - SHUKRAN!

We invite you to join us for 5 challenging days trekking in Jordan's desert, mountain, canyon and wadi landscapes, as we cross through the Dana Biosphere Reserve to the Nabatean masterpiece "half as old as time":

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Day (1) Arrival at Queen Alia International

Airport – Amman Welcome to Jordan! Arrive at Amman Airport, where our ground team will meet you and assist with immigration before transferring you to our hotel. Amman is one of the oldest cities in the world, inhabited since the bronze age. The city is growing into a modern city but retains its character and history. Depending on your time of arrival, a city tour can take place. No meals confirmed however a

welcome dinner will be arranged if all participants arrive in time – pending final flight arrival times. Transfer time from airport into Amman: Approx. 30min-1hr depending on traffic. Overnight in Amman at 4 star city centre hotel.



Day (2) Amman - Hike from Dana Village to

Feynan/Wadi Ghweir Area - 16Km At 7:00am group departs from our hotel in Amman. The drive from Amman to Wadi Dana where we will begin the hike is about 3 hours. Once we arrive, the hike will start from Dana Village, 1,200m above sea level, and head west into Dana valley with your trekking guides. The trail drops steeply at first and then levels into a more gradual descent through the Dana Biosphere Reserve towards the Wadi Ghuweir. The reserve, Jordan's largest,

includes four distinct bio-geographical zones, which means that Dana supports an astonishing diversity of birds, plants, and animals. On your way down the valley you may see Griffin Vultures overhead as well as hyrax and copper-blue lizards on the rocks; if you're lucky you might even catch a glimpse of an ibex or a desert fox, or see the footprint of a wolf in the dust. Overnight wilderness camping in Wadi Ghuweir. Hiking Distance 16Km, Ascent 280m, Descent 1420m. Hiking Level: Moderate. Driving distance from Amman to Dana: around 3 hours. All meals & water for trekking provided.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE - We will follow a trail along the mountains overlooking Dana valley and then descend into Al Khashasha valley where a wilderness campsite awaits the group.

Hiking distance is around 15KM. Takes around 5-7 Hours.

Ascent 260M.Descent 600M.



Day (3) Wadi Ghweir - Hike from Wadi Ghweir

to Furon/Ras Al Feid 16.5Km On this day, we leave Wadi Ghuweir and start our hike heading towards Furon. As we pass the entrance to Wadi Ghuweir we'll ascend up through the mountains with great views behind. This is a steep and challenging section of the route, but extremely rewarding. The track leads up into the mountains through a dramatic valley that offers stunning and wonderful views towards the fascinating Wadi Araba Desert. In the

afternoon you'll reach the camp set up by our crew at Furon. Overnight wilderness camping in Furon. Hiking Distance 16.5Km, Ascent 1320m, Descent 390m, Difficulty Level: Difficult. All meals & water for trekking provided.



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Day (4) Furon - Hike from Furon to Ghbour

Whedat / Hiking Distance: 17Km On this day, we start hiking from Furon past Ras Al-Feid towards Ghbour Whedat. Today we will witness astonishing views into the some of the most remote and wildest corners of Jordan. Contouring the Sharah Mountains, follow a trail of mostly clear Bedouin shepherd paths. The sheer peaks of black mountains overlooking our trail and steep precipitous drops of the canyons below make this day absolutely spectacular. We will gradually climb up the hills to uncover more of the spectacular views over the desert


below. Then, we will proceed to our wilderness campsite in Ghbour Whedat. Overnight wilderness camping in Ghbour Whedat. Hiking Distance 17Km, Ascent 750m, Descent 920m Hiking, Level: Difficult. All meals & water for trekking provided.



Day (5) Ghbour Whedat - Hike from Ghbour

Whedat to Little Petra - 14Km After yesterday's very remote hike, today while we approach Little Petra, we see signs of increasing human habitation. Along the way we pass Bedouin camps, sheep pens, and small agricultural plots. In this region between Ghbour Whedat and Little Petra we also pass Nabatean ruins, some of which may include wine and olive presses, aqueducts and other ancient water infrastructures. Today we will visit Little Petra, believed by archaeologist to be a "suburb" of Petra, and meant to house traders traveling along the silk road

connecting Africa to Asia, Europe and Arabia. Touring Little Petra, we will see rock carved facades, houses and other ancient buildings carved into the sandstone canyon. Overnight at a Bedouin Camp in Little Petra. Hiking Distance 14Km, Ascent 610m, Descent 560m Hiking Level: Moderate. All meals & water for trekking provided.



Day (6) Little Petra - Hike from Little Petra to Petra - Hiking Distance: 16KM

After breakfast we begin our hike towards Petra – our official finish line! We enter Petra via 'The Back Door' avoiding most of the tourists and our local expert guides will tour us around the monument. To arrive at Petra, good tracks go pleasantly down Wadi Ghurab amidst sandstone mountains guarding the approaches to Petra. This way follows a Nabataean route out of the valley and skirting round the final mountain on a natural rock terrace which has been 'improved' for the safety of walkers. Even so, it still narrows slightly before reaching a hidden

plateau high above the impressive chasm of Wadi Siyyagh. Just beyond, carved into the cliff face, 'The Monastery' suddenly comes into view, where there is a Bedouin café for refreshments if you would like. The Nabataean Steps lead down into ancient Petra; through which the route goes before exiting past 'The Treasury' and though the famous 'Petra Siq' to the shops, cafés and hotels of Wadi Musa. Overnight in Wadi Musa, Petra. Hotel Petra Palace <http://www.petrpalace.com/> Hiking Distance 16Km, Ascent 421m, Descent 471m Hiking Level: Moderate. All meals & water for trekking provided. Tonight we'll have a celebratory dinner at our hotel!



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Day (7) Petra - Queen Alia International Airport -

Departure After breakfast we transfer you direct to *Queen Alia International Airport*, Amman to catch your departure flight home. Travel distance from Petra to QAIA is appx. 3 hours. Alternatively, you can extend your Jordan experience and travel for example to the beautiful Wadi Rum south of Petra and/or explore the Dead Sea and feel the weightlessness of this phenomenal body of water! We can advise you on local tour options or feel free to discover the many options that are out there. Please note that our

final night is in Petra (3 hours south of Amman). For this reason you will want to plan your extension from here as most of Jordan's highlights exist in the south.



EXPEDITION PRICE: (recommended process)

..... * Expedition Cost and Sponsorship Minimum Target (*Flights not included*)

This is a non-profit event whose aim is to raise funds for charitable projects carried out by YOUR ORGANIZATION. What's Included in your Event Payment:

- 2 nights hotel accommodation (1st and final nights) in 3 or 4 star tourist hotel centrally located, shared room
- 3 nights camping experience including materials: 2 person shared tent, bed foam, basic camp washing / toilet facilities and meals catered by local expedition staff
- 1 night in Bedouin style fixed camp
- Daily transfers of your personal baggage between camps



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- Daily meals as per itinerary included filtered or mineral water on trekking days, coffee and tea
- Entrance permits, guide and fees for Little Petra and Petra UNESCO monument
- Tipping for all local guides, drivers & camp support staff (included in the price this year)

- Arrival VISA (single entrance) for Jordan
- All permits and legal access to trekking areas

What's Not Included:

- Flight to/from trip starting/finishing point: Amman, Jordan (Queen Alia International Airport code: AMM)
- Personal Expedition Travel insurance and **recommended cancellation / trip disruption insurance**
- Soft/alcoholic drinks, any personal expenses, private transfers/taxis, entrance fees, hotel mini-bar etc
- Single room supplements (limited availability)
