## 2 Day - Granada Cultural & Natural Exploration

Granada is an important cultural and historical symbol for Andalucía and España. For students, it's a great example of both heritage and fantastic natural landscapes. Our excursion combines both aspects and we guarantee this trip is educational, active and inspiring for all interests – especially for bonding and teamwork as a group. We are certain you will enjoy this diverse adventure to kick start your school year or celebrate the end of year!

### Day 1 MULTI ADVENTURE SIERRA NEVADA—Your

Adventurebug Leader will be meeting you at Monachil – Los Cahorros Park 30 minutes from Granada center. Activities include small group rotations of: *Rock Climbing, Canyon Trek over suspension bridges, Rappel and Zip Lining* in an impressive natural canyon within Sierra Nevada National Park. Later we check into the hostel with dinner. Night program includes some social games with your Adventurebug Leader.

- 0900 Departure by coach from School / optional stop on route for toilet and refreshments.  
1300 Arrival to Monachil village (Los Cahorros in Sierra Nevada park)  
1400 Begin adventure and natural activities in the canyon of Los Cahorros, Sierra Nevada (walking into canyon necessary)  
1800 Completion of Adventure program/Bus transfer to the Hostel (40 min) / settle in time / orientation and boundaries  
2000 Dinner in Hostel followed by evening games and challenges and a pre-bed briefing led by Adventurebug  
2200 End of program for the day.

**Day 2 CULTURAL GRANADA** Visit Granada's historic center - including a part of the *Alhambra Palace* with a treasure hunt of the city's best places, followed by the Science Center. Breakfast and Picnic Lunch included. Return to School 17:30 by private coach transfer

- 0800 Breakfast in hostel  
0845 Load bus and depart for the Alhambra area followed by a guided walk and treasure hunt of the historic center of Granada – including the Moorish souks and the central quarter. Note, the group will not have a visit INTO the Alhambra and only some aspects of it will be covered due to time and school group access restraints.  
10.45 Arrival to the Parque Ciencias (Science Park), for a few hours visit. Pack lunches (brought from the hostel), can be eaten at the open lunch area in the center.  
1400 Return journey approximately 3.5 hours with optional services break on route.  
1730 Approximate LATEST arrival time to School

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## SAFETY EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The information below is to assist teacher leaders and monitors with managing risk and potential hazards on our trips. It also offers practical advice in the event of emergencies and provides a resource base of contact numbers to rescue personal. In the event of any emergency it's important to stay calm, get all the facts and be sure that you and the other children are safe and accounted for.

### Recommendations for Safe Practice on School Adventure Trips:

1. Ensure a **FIRST AID** kit is carried on all days (Adventurebug will always have one)
2. Teachers and Activity Monitors set safety boundaries for children and give warning to any possible hazards including weather patterns, terrain, wildlife, road hazards, public areas and any items of nature that could be a danger.
3. Communication system in place between groups and their supervising leaders and teachers – exchange mobile phone numbers and have a central meeting point each day that everybody is familiar with.
4. Always watch out for one's personal safety in areas of outdoor pursuits and double check on fellow peers when doing activities.
5. Keep within boundaries and respect monitor's judgement and authority.
6. Ensure that an escape route / plan is in place and / or provisions for repatriating an injured or sick from an activity site.
7. Respect all safety equipment and installations.

### In the event of any accident or serious illness scenario:

If working with the Adventurebug monitors on activities – tell them what has happened and they will launch their own emergency procedures.

If not: Provide any necessary First Aid to casualty & call in further Emergency Services if necessary. Our first line of assistance is:

Medical services – call Euro emergency number 112

Rescue services – call Guardia Civil 062

Criminal scenario – call Guardia Civil 062

Ensure the rest of group is together and not in any danger If hospital services required, 1 staff member and then appropriate a parent or garden, accompany patient to hospital. **INSURANCE AND REGISTRATION FOR A PATIENT.** Adventurebug has an internal medical emergency policy to speedily register with the Spanish National Health Service. Our insurance policy (and because they are minor in age), ensures they get prompt treatment from emergency services care. **PLEASE HAVE A DOCUMENT WITH THE STUDENTS NAME, ADDRESS AND FAMILY DETAILS available!** Ensure a Spanish speaker is present (*teacher or designated adult preferred*). Based on severity of incident, decide how to best carry on activity session with group.

### In the event of a lost person:

1. Ensure all other members of group are accounted for first.
2. Get as much information regarding location person last was seen.
3. Contact supervising monitor to advise.
4. Follow instructions of supervisor.
5. Keep rest of group in one place under adult supervision.
6. Should person not be found within 20 min / and depending on environment / call emergency services (Guardia Civil) for support.
