#### Day 1 MULTI ADVENTURE LAKE DAY -

Private coach transfer to Granada, (Bermejales Lake)

**40 minutes from city center. Activities include small group rotations of paddle surf, canoes, pedal boats and archery: Dinner included.**

0900 Departure by coach from School / stop on route for toilet and refreshments

Please bring pack lunch for day 1

1200 Arrival to Bermejales Lake for full afternoon of water based adventures and nature games.

1800 Completion of Adventure program followed by a short journey to hostel.

2000 Dinner in Hostel followed by evening games and challenges with Adventurebug

#### Day 2 CULTURAL GRANADA – Guided educational visit to some regions of the

**Alhambra Palace including a historical walk of the Albaizan quarter and a visit to the Cathedral and Moorish Quarters. Afternoon program includes Ice Skating and an evening Bowling tournament. Breakfast, pack lunch and dinner included.**

0800 Breakfast in hostel

0845 Depart by bus for Alhambra Palace for guided visit of the free spaces of the Alhambra and Palacio

Carlos V. Walk from Alhambra to the Plaza Nueva and historic center of Granada. Guided tour of the Albaizan district, Moorish souks and entrance to the famous Cathedral of Granada. Picnic lunch in shaded area.

1500 1 hour free supervised time for exploration and shopping in small groups in the Bib Rambla district.

1630 Ice Skating Session.

1800 Transfer to the Hostel (20 min)

2000 Dinner in Hostel followed by BOWLING tournament (10 min walk from hostel)

2200 End of program for the day.

**Day 3 GRANADA SCIENCE PARK - Full morning in Science Center - located in the city center. Exploration of many science themes including the Birds of Prey Workshop. Breakfast and lunch included.**

0800 Breakfast in hostel / Room tidy and packing

0900 Check out of room / load bus and depart for Granada's Parque Ciencias

1000 Visits in small groups to the Science departments in the museum including some workshops.

1400 Completion of program / pack lunch (provided) and departure for bus. Return to School.

## SAFETY EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The information below is to assist teacher leaders and monitors with managing risk and potential hazards on our trips. It also offers practical advice in the event of emergencies and provides a resource base of contact numbers to rescue personnel. In the event of any emergency it's important to stay calm, get all the facts and be sure that you and the other children are safe and accounted for.

### Recommendations for Safe Practice on School Adventure Trips:

1. Ensure a **FIRST AID** kit is carried on all days (Adventurebug will always have one)
2. Teachers and Activity Monitors set safety boundaries for children and give warning to any possible hazards including weather patterns, terrain, wildlife, road hazards, public areas and any items of nature that could be a danger.
3. Communication system in place between groups and their supervising leaders and teachers – exchange mobile phone numbers and have a central meeting point each day that everybody is familiar with.
4. Always watch out for one's personal safety in areas of outdoor pursuits and double check on fellow peers when doing activities.
5. Keep within boundaries and respect monitor's judgement and authority.
6. Ensure that an escape route / plan is in place and / or provisions for repatriating an injured or sick from an activity site.
7. Respect all safety equipment and installations.

### In the event of any accident or serious illness scenario:

If working with the Adventurebug monitors on activities – tell them what has happened and they will launch their own emergency procedures. If not: Provide any necessary First Aid to casualty & call in further Emergency Services if necessary. Our first line of assistance is:

Medical services – call Euro emergency number 112

Rescue services – call Guardia Civil 062

Criminal scenario – call Guardia Civil 062

Ensure the rest of group is together and not in any danger. If hospital services required, 1 staff member and then appropriate a parent or guardian, accompany patient to hospital. **INSURANCE AND REGISTRATION FOR A PATIENT.** Adventurebug has an internal medical emergency policy to speedily register with the Spanish National Health Service. Our insurance policy (and because they are minor in age), ensures they get prompt treatment from emergency services care. **PLEASE HAVE A DOCUMENT WITH THE STUDENTS NAME, ADDRESS AND FAMILY DETAILS** available! Ensure a Spanish speaker is present (*teacher or designated adult preferred*). Based on severity of incident, decide how to best carry on activity session with group.

### In the event of a lost person:

1. Ensure all other members of group are accounted for first.
2. Get as much information regarding location person last was seen.
3. Contact supervising monitor to advise.
4. Follow instructions of supervisor.
5. Keep rest of group in one place under adult supervision.
6. Should person not be found within 20 min / and depending on environment / call emergency services (Guardia Civil) for support.
