Insurance (Asistencia en Viaje and Responsibility Civil) is fully provided per participant and staff member. A **RISK ASSESSMENT** and Emergency Safety Protocol specific to each trip is always provided.

Instead, we promote these trips based on their well-rounded features that include where possible; social activities, art, music, writing, intercommunicative games and self-discovery on various levels.

4 Day Cadiz Coast & Seville Multi Adventure

Seville and Tarifa's Atlantic Coast

Cadiz and Seville are Jewels of Andalusian culture and history. For students, it's a fascinating region that intrigues every imagination. We explore the best on offer for your age group! Along with visits to Sevilla city we explore Bolonia's Roman Ruins, Tarifa's

beaches as well as the famous El Chorro. Combined we have days of culture, adventure and interactive time with our fellow classmates and teachers!

Day 1 TARIFA ADVENTURE DAY – This morning our private coach takes us directly to our adventure site at Tarifa. Here we divide into two groups – one visits the beach of Punta Paloma for Olympic challenges while the other visits our Adventure Park where we have activities in small group rotations: *Rock Climbing, Cave Necropolis Trek, Rappel, Archery, a zip line and more!* (groups rotate after 1.5 hours). Upon completion we travel direct to Seville, Andalusia's shining capital and check in for 3 nights at our hostel near the city center. Evening briefing and team building fun with your Adventurebug leader. *Buffet dinner at hostel included (please bring lunch from school).*

Day 2 ALCAZAR PALACE & ISLA MAGICA – This morning we have an educational visit to Seville's remarkable *Alcazar Palace* and perhaps some shopping and exploration time in Seville followed a full afternoon of adventure fun at Isla Magica Theme Park. This evening your Adventurebug leader will coordinate some fun games and challenges at the hostel. *Breakfast, lunch at Isla Magica, buffet dinner at hostel included.*



Day 3 CULTURAL SEVILLE & AQUAPOLIS WATER PARK – In the cooler hours this morning we visit Seville's historic ITALICA Roman Ruins followed by a visit to *Plaza España* including the row boats, and the *Botanical Gardens Maria Luisa* before we hit the Aquapolis Water Park for a full afternoon of fun! This evening we return to the hostel for relaxation and our final dinner.

Breakfast, lunch at water park, buffet dinner at hostel included.

Day 4 EI CHORRO – ARDALES LAKE a transfer of 2.5 hours to El Chorro where we arrive at the Ardales lake for rotations of fun, interactive outdoor based activities including kayak, raft building, a guided nature discovery trek and team building with a Picnic lunch in the forest at the activity site. Travel back to school.

Breakfast, packed lunch included.

SAFETY EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The information below is to assist teacher leaders and monitors with managing risk and potential hazards on our trips. It also offers practical advice in the event of emergencies and provides a resource base of contact numbers to rescue personal. In the event of any emergency it's important to stay calm, get all the facts and be sure that you and the other children are safe and accounted for.

Recommendations for Safe Practice on School Adventure Trips:

1. Ensure a **FIRST AID** kit is carried on all days (Adventurebug will always have one)
2. Teachers and Activity Monitors set safety boundaries for children and give warning to any possible hazards including weather patterns, terrain, wildlife, road hazards, public areas and any items of nature that could be a danger.
3. Communication system in place between groups and their supervising leaders and teachers – exchange mobile phone numbers and have a central meeting point each day that everybody is familiar with.
4. Always watch out for one's personal safety in areas of outdoor pursuits and double check on fellow peers when doing activities.
5. Keep within boundaries and respect monitor's judgement and authority.
6. Ensure that an escape route / plan is in place and / or provisions for repatriating an injured or sick from an activity site.
7. Respect all safety equipment and installations.

In the event of any accident or serious illness scenario:

If working with the Adventurebug monitors on activities – tell them what has happened and they will launch their own emergency procedures. If not: Provide any necessary First Aid to casualty & call in further Emergency Services if necessary. Our first line of assistance is:

Medical services – call Euro emergency number 112

Rescue services – call Guardia Civil 062

Criminal scenario – call Guardia Civil 062

Ensure the rest of group is together and not in any danger If hospital services required, 1 staff member and then appropriate a parent or guardian, accompany patient to hospital. **INSURANCE AND REGISTRATION FOR A PATIENT.** Adventurebug has an internal medical emergency policy to speedily register with the Spanish National Health Service. Our insurance policy (and because they are minor in age), ensures they get prompt treatment from emergency services care. **PLEASE HAVE A DOCUMENT WITH THE STUDENTS NAME, ADDRESS AND FAMILY DETAILS available!** Ensure a Spanish speaker is present (*teacher or designated adult preferred*). Based on severity of incident, decide how to best carry on activity session with group.

In the event of a lost person:

1. Ensure all other members of group are accounted for first.
2. Get as much information regarding location person last was seen.
3. Contact supervising monitor to advise.
4. Follow instructions of supervisor.
5. Keep rest of group in one place under adult supervision.
6. Should person not be found within 20 min / and depending on environment / call emergency services (Guardia Civil) for support.

Note – this information is a guideline only and Adventurebug cannot be held responsible for the handling and procedures – including outcomes of emergency responses as every scenario is unique and requires specialized attention – we will however do our absolute best to provide the highest "Duty of Care" to any person involved in our programs.
